# CAYUGA LAKE CRUISING FLEET PHRF APPLICATION

Measurements of **P**, **I**, and **E** may be to limiting permanent blackband or to limit of travel. Measure **I** to higher of forestay intersection or spinnaker sheave top. Measurement of spinnaker pole length is from center of front face of mast to outboard end of pole set athwart ship. Spinnaker length (**SL**) is straight line from top of head to outside of clew with spinnaker spread flat. **LP** is "least perpendicular distance from luff to outside of clew of largest Genoa jib."
