

The IYC Cayuga Lake Cruising Fleet Sheldrake Cup Sunday, August 2nd, 2020 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing of the Cayuga Lake Cruising Fleet.

2 **RESPONSIBILITY**

It is the sole responsibility of each skipper to decide whether to start or to continue the race. Skippers are responsible for safely mooring their boats.

3 ENTRIES

Any sailboat is eligible to enter. There is no fee to enter the race.

Enter by registering via email to <u>CayugaLakeCruisingFleet@gmail.com</u> or at the Ithaca Yacht Club South Pavilion before the competitors' meeting.

All entries are STRONGLY ENCOURAGED to carry a GPS reading time in seconds and a VHF radio.

4 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

No Signals will be made ashore. If a postponement is needed an announcement will be made at the IYC South Pavilion, and on VHF channel 80.

5 COMPETITOR'S MEETING

A competitors' meeting will be held at 7:45am, at the IYC South Pavilion. The meeting is not mandatory.

6 THE START

6.1. The starting line will be between Mark A (off the IYC lawn) and the Yacht Club flagpole. Boats will start in a Northerly direction.

6.2. The race committee shall assign a starting time to each boat based on her rating.

6.3. The RC will attempt to give an accurate 5-minute warning by sound signal for the first start. This signal may also be broadcast on VHF channel 80. However, the start is determined by GPS time, not by the sound/VHF.

6.4. Additional boats will start at their assigned start times. No sound signals will be given for additional starts.

6.5. Competitors will record their finish times as accurately as possible, and will note the approximate position of other boats in the vicinity. They must give this information to the RC as soon as possible after the RC's boat has docked.

6.6. GPS recordings will be used to determine actual start and finish times.

7 COURSE

The course will be from the Start to the Finish at Sheldrake Point. The total distance is 12.6 nautical miles.

If the wind is light, the race committee may announce an alternative Short Course at the competitor's meeting.

8 FINISHING LINE

The finish shall be a line extending from the red pile cluster at Sheldrake Point (#142) on a bearing of 070° magnetic, for a distance of 100 yards. The easterly end of the finish line is not marked by a buoy, but is at 42°40.104'N, 76°41.879'W

Each boat shall make a note of any boats finishing just ahead or behind them.

9 TIME LIMIT

The time limit for the race will be five hours from the first start.

RRS 35 applies: If one boat in a class sails the course and finishes with the time limit, all boats in the same class that finish shall be scored according to their finishing places unless the race is abandoned. If no boat finishes within the time limit, the race committee shall abandon the race.

10 RATINGS

The CLCF's time-on-distance PHRF ratings will be used.

Boats without a PHRF certificate or rating are welcome. The race committee will try to find a rating for you.

11 PROTESTS

Protests shall be lodged verbally with a fleet officer at the finish, or at the IYC, within one hour after the fleet officer's boat is moored. Hearings will be held as soon as possible after the race.

12 TROPHIES

The Sheldrake Cup will be awarded to the first boat to finish in the PHRF Keelboat class. This historic trophy was first awarded in the year 1902.
