Second Race Day of the Spring Series, Sunday, May 15

The NOAA Finger Lakes Recreational Boating Forecast called for westerly winds between 10 and 15 knots. We never saw that kind of wind until long after the second race.

For the first race we got what every sailor hates, "light and variable winds," in this case 0-4 knots, chiefly from the Northwest, but sometimes also from the South and East. To make our suffering brief, the Fleet Captain chose a short course, first north to Maplewood, then south to the new West Shore mark, and then back to the Yacht Club. Due to the drifty conditions, the fleet was strung out over 25 minutes from the first to the last finisher.

For the second race, the wind became more steady and picked up a bit, occasionally reaching 8 knots. The Fleet Captain therefore chose a longer course, north to Ladoga and then back to the Yacht Club. This time the fleet stayed pretty close together with everyone finishing within less than a minute of each other.

Once again, there were only B-Fleet boats at the start, a total of 6 of them. The first race was won by CLCF Fleet Captain, David Feavearyear, and his crew aboard their J-24, SNITCH. The second race was won by Peter Gould and his crew with their J-22, WHARF RAT. The current points leader in the Spring Series is Clare Fewtrell's J-24, MEHITABEL.
