### **Third Race Day of the Fall Series, Sunday, October 2**

Here we are near the end of the Fall Series, and we get summer drifter conditions. Although we were blessed with lots of sunshine and temperatures in the low 80s, we were also cursed with very light and at times zero wind. We could sail only one race, and we had to postpone that one by over 40 minutes until there was enough wind to start.

Nine boats showed up for today's race, two in A-Fleet and seven in B-Fleet. The race course went first south to Sycamore, then northeast to the East Shore mark, and from there southwest to the start-finish line at the Yacht Club.

For the first leg to Sycamore, we still had about 5 knots of wind. But after we rounded the Sycamore mark, the wind began to fizzle, and by the time we got to the East Shore mark, we were chiefly drifting. For most of us, the final part of the last leg to the start-finish line was pure agony. The knot meters read 0.0, and when there seemed to be a shift in the barely perceptible zephyr, we had no steerage-way to change course. The captains and crews of two boats decided to take DNFs rather than prolong their suffering.

The A-Fleet winner was the Corsair 28, TREVELYAN, skippered by Richard Stephens, and the B-Fleet winner was the J-24, SNITCH, skippered by Dave Feavearyear.
