2005 Awards Banquet, Sunday, October 30

This year's awards banquet was better attended than last year's (68 vs 58 people). 10 Cruising Fleet boats were represented by their skippers and/or crews.

The program began with the annual report by the Fleet Captain. Dave Feavearyear mentioned that in 2005 we lost eight skippers who had been registered the previous year but picked up four new members. We therefore registered only 13 boats in 2005, that's 4 boats fewer than last year.

Feavearyear also reported that we had originally scheduled 24 races but sailed only 18. We had to cancel 4 races for weather related reasons and 2 because of a scheduling conflict.

The annual report was followed by the presentation of the silver and glass-ware trophies and the trophy flags and for first through third places in the spring, mid-distance, and fall series of races. A list of these awards is on the next page.

The Cruising Fleet awards ceremonies concluded with the presentation of the Bent Stanchion Award and the Boat-of-the-Year Award. The Bent Stanchion Award went to the J-22 **Wharf Rat,** skippered by Peter Gould, who t-boned the J-24, **mehitabel,** skippered by Clare Fewtrell, and put a fist sized hole into her hull during the start of the third spring series race. The Boat-of-the-Year award was presented—for the second year in a row—to the J-24, **Snitch**, skippered by David Feavearyear, who accumulated 7 first places (the runner-up had 5 wins).
