### **Third Race Day of the Fall Series, Sunday, September 24**

In some of the closest racing this year, we held our 3<sup>rd</sup> racing day of the fall series. After a short postponement, the first was a course up to Ladoga and back in a shifty and puffy westerly wind. Only one boat flew their spinnaker on the leg back to the club (shortly after the helmsman told his crew "it would be suicide to fly a chute today"). After a nice fast race, Watt Webb on "WaveTrain" led the race and took the line honors with "Snitch" taking first on corrected time. Unfortunately the wind subsided as the fleet was finishing and after drifting for a while, we started a second race going to Maplewood, across to East Shore and back based on a request to have at least one windward leg (which one was to be determined later). As the fleet bunched up at Maplewood the wind again picked up for a fast reach to East Shore (more spinnakers this time) and a difficult, shifty, puffy beat back to the club. This time Mel Richards on "Lorelei" was able to make ground on the last leg to take the line honors with Clare Fewtrell on "mehitabel" taking the corrected time.

**Reminder! (Per Section 4.3 c of the 2006 SI's):** Avoiding the Start/Finish Line. Except when starting, finishing, or rounding Mark A when it is a mark in the course, no boat shall cross between Mark A and the Yacht Club point while racing. Also, so as not to obstruct the view of the race committee, no boat shall cross back through the line after finishing. Violation of this rule will result in disqualification.

The skippers' meeting will be at 12:45 p.m. at the South Pavilion for the Keelboat Race, with the start 1:30 p.m.
