## Final Day of the Spring Series, Sunday, June 22

Another sunny, but shifty wind day on Cayuga Lake, greeted us for the final race day of the spring series. We set a course going to East shore, Maplewood, the Club with a Maplewood add on that was later dropped due to a dying breeze. As the wind oscillated, we ended up with a spinnaker start, but through the course we changed sails 4 or 5 times. As the fleet separated and recombined, the lead was up for grabs until the very end. Once the times were set and results calculated, it was Mel Richards and crew on "Lorelei" taking the win for the day and tying the lead for the series. Base on the second places, Eberhard Alsen and crew on "Fantasy" ended up winning the Cup for the Spring Series, with "Lorelei" in second and Clare Fewtrell on "mehitabel" in third.

The parade was a lot of fun again this year. The rain passed over before we started so we actually finished in the dry for once. We will be posting photos and video on the website shortly for you to see.

## From the Fleet Captain:

Our next event will be next Sunday, June 29<sup>th</sup>. All sailboats are welcome to join in (dinghies, beach-cats, etc all included). There are no entry requirements, and no prizes. We'll go round a course from the Club (A) to East shore (F) and back clockwise (starboard side mark roundings) as many times as we can in the two hours. The start will be between the point and the A mark, in the northerly direction. If you start a lap (ie round the A mark) before 4pm, you may finish that lap. Two special rules: First, human powered propulsion (sculling, rocking, etc) is permitted. Second, because crews may be working up a sweat, water balloons, water cannons, etc may be used! The goal for the fleet is to complete a total of 50 laps! (Maybe we could make it more interesting and raise money for a worthy cause). Each lap is 1.77NM, so I figure about 20 minutes per lap at 5knts.

Skipper's meeting will be at 1:30 pm and the event will start at 2:00 pm
