First Day of the Fall Series, Sunday, September 7th

The Fall Series started with a great day of sailing, partly sunny skies, nice Northerly wind and 9 boats at the line, including newcomer Trevor French and crew on "Hanna Jane," a Catalina Capri 22, the Cornell Sailing Team bringing Aujourd'hui back for a visit and the Cornell Large Boat Competitive PE class on the J24 "Reverie." We did two races since the wind was cooperating. The first race went to Maplewood, Sycamore, back to Maplewood and finishing at the club. The second race was set for a longer course going first to Crowbar, around the club pin, up to Maplewood and back to the finish.

The first race was lead to the line by Richard Stephens and crew on "Trevelyan" with a close race for second boat across between "Snitch (flying a pole-less spinnaker)," "mehitabel" and "Fantasy." After the times were calculated, it was the Feavearyears on "Snitch" in first with Clare Fewtrell and Eberhard Alsen on "mehitabel" and "Fantasy" tying for second.

The second race had a little more wind variation but again Richard on "Trevelyan" took the line honors but this time Clare on "mehitabel" corrected first, followed by "Snitch" and "Fantasy."
