Second Day of the Fall Series, Sunday, September 14th

Another nice day for sailing greeted the second day of the Fall Series. With the threat of changing weather from hurricane Ike, we did get two races in before any of the bad weather and large wind fields hit Cayuga Lake. With the wind from the south-westerly direction, we set the first course to go to Sycamore, around the Barge and back to the finish having mostly a windward-leeward course. The second race we set a conservative course of Sycamore to Maplewood, twice around, in case the weather deteriorated and we needed to shorten course. Luckily the weather held and we were able to complete both laps, only having a few puffs in the higher teens through out the day.

Both races had Clare Fewtrell and crew on "mehitabel" lead the fleet around the race course taking the line honors and corrected wins. The next two positions were shared by the Feavearyears on "Snitch" and Eberhard Alsen on "Fantasy" with "Snitch" beating "Fantasy" in the first race, but "Fantasy" taking the corrected second in the second race.

The racing will start at 12 noon and will have as many races as possible run (targeting 3) before the last race start cut off time of 4 pm. If he doesn't get a minimum of 5 boats registered, there will not be a keel boat fleet this year. The cost is \$25 per boat and the invitation has been extended to include CLCF boats.

Snitch, crew and family will be attending the Fall Colors Regatta in Lake George once again on the weekend of September 28th. If anyone is interested in performing the timing crew duties that day, please let me know and we can get you trained in the next two weeks
