First Race Day of the Spring Series, Sunday, May 3

The first race day of the season was a drifter with wind directions ranging from NE to SW. We had temperatures in the 60s under mostly overcast skies.

Five boats showed up at the starting line, Tim Bonniwell's Catalina 30, Richard Stephens' Corsair F28, Eberhard Alsen's Tanzer 25, and the J24s of Clare Fewtrell and David Feavearyear.

The course that Fleet Captain Stephens picked was "BJ," that is, first north to the new Near Maplewood mark, then south to the West Shore mark, and from there home to the finish line.

Due to lack of wind there was a half-hour postponement, and due to the flukey conditions we were able to sail only one race (The last competitor crossed the finish line after the 3:30 cut off time).

As is typical in drifters, the lead changed several times. In the end, Richard Stephens' triamaran took line honors and Eberhard Alsen's Tanzer won on corrected time.
