Fifth Race Day of the Spring Series, Sunday, June 7

Although the weather forecast called showers in the afternoon, it didn't begin to rain until after we had gathered under the roof of the South Pavilion for the usual post-race get together.

The first race was briefly delayed due to lack of wind, and then the Fleet Captain sent us on a short course north to the near Maplewood mark, then south to the West Shore mark, and from there back to the start finish line.

We had the usual six suspects at the starting line plus Judge Mulvey with his C&C 27, PATRIOT, who sailed only the first of today's two races.

For the second race, the wind had picked up a bit, so we went north to the Grey Barge near the Cargill plant and then back to the Yacht Club.

Line honors in both races went to Richard Stephens' Corsair 28, TREVELIAN. On corrected time, the first race was won by the folks on David Feavearyear's J24, SNITCH, and the second race by the crew on Eberhard Alsen's Tanzer 25, FANTASY.
