Final Race Day of the Spring Series, Sunday, June 14

The weather gods smiled on us today and gave us sunny skies with temperatures in the 70s and a steady northerly breeze between 4 and 10 knots.

The usual six combatant showed up to do battle: a C&C 30, a Catalina 30, a Corsair 28, a Tanzer 25, and two J24s.

The first race was a short-haul affair, going to north the far Maplewood mark, then south to the West shore mark, then north again to the near Maplewood mark, and from there home for a downwind finish. As usual, Richard Stephens' Corsair 28 TREVELYAN took line honors, but David Feavearyear's J24 SNITCH won on corrected time.

For the second race, the Fleet Captain sent us all the way north to the over-on-its-side Crowbar mark, and from there home to the Yacht Club for an upwind finish. Again TREVELYAN took line honors, but this time Clare Fewtrell's J24 MEHITABEL won on corrected time,
