Fifth Race Day of the Latitude Series, Sunday, August 16

With blazing heat and a shifty breeze, our fleet captain set the course for Latitude B, which for most of us was just South of Myers Point. We had a 0 to 10 knot breeze that could only be described as West-ish, since it was clocking anywhere from North-east to South-west, sometimes within a boat length. But due to the foresight of a shorter course, all boats were able to finish well within the new time limit and most only had one small delay in the doldrums.

Five boats showed up to race, and behind the first boat back, it was a very close finish, with the places changing frequently form the near Maplewood to the finish line. In the end, the Feavearyear's J24, "Snitch" took first; Richard Stephen's Corsair 28, "Trevelyan" second (with guest helmsman Luke Miller); and Clare Fewtrell's J24 "mehitabel" third.
