Fourth Race Day of the Fall Series, Sunday, September 27

To sum up this day, I would have to say that a miserable time was had by all. First of all, it rained throughout both races and the temperatures were only in the high 50s. Secondly, the wind was flukey, ranging from near 0 knots in some places to 6-8 knots in others. Moreover, there was such a strong current near Maplewood that one boat was seen to drift backwards and had to make three approaches before being able to round the "B" mark.

Five boats fought those unfavorable conditions: Richard Stephens' Corsair 28, TREVELYAN; Tim Bonniwell's Catalina 30, INVICTUS; Eberhard Alsen's Tanzer 25, FANTASY; and MEHITABEL and SNITCH, the J-24s of Clare Fewtrell and David Feavearyear.

The first race went north to the near Maplewood mark, from there south to Sycamore, back to the Maplewood mark, and then to a downwind finish at the Yacht Club. The second and shorter race also went first to the near Maplewood mark, from there south to the West Shore mark, and then to an upwind finish at the Club.

The first race was won by Tim Bonniwell and crew aboard INVICTUS, the second race by Clare Fewtrell and crew aboard MEHITABEL. Complete race results are on the following page, and so are the corrected results of the Fall Series Race # 6 (September 20), plus the current Fall Series Standings.

Frostbite Regatta, Sunday, October 4
