Fifth Race Day of the Spring Series, Sunday, June 6

Last Sunday we would have liked a bit more wind, but today we got more wind than we needed. It blew 18-20 knots out of the NW, with gusts up to 30. Plus we got occasional rain which hit us horizontally because of the almost gale-force wind.

There were round-ups galore, and INVICTUS had two spinnaker broaches in quick succession. It looked almost as if they liked the first broach so much that they started the second one deliberately.

Five boats braved the elements: Mel Richard's C&C 30, LORELEI; Tim Bonniwell's Catalina 30, INVICTUS; Richard Stephens' Corsair 28, TREVELYAN; Eberhard Alsen's Tanzer 25, FANTASY; and David Feavearyear's J-24, SNITCH.

We sailed two races over the same BH course: North to the Near Maplewood mark, south to the Pile Cluster by Stewart Park, and then back north to the finish line at the Yacht Club.

Given the wind conditions and the length of the course, it was not surprising that Richard Stephens' triamaran TREVELYAN won both races.

With today's back-to-back first places, TREVELYAN moved into the lead in the Spring Series Point Standings. With one more race to go, only LORELEI and INVICTUS have a theoretical chance of beating TREVELYAN for the Spring Series trophy.
