Fifth Latitude Race, Sunday, August 15

The weather for this event consisted of intermittent rain and drizzle with temperatures in the high 70s. But at least we had a steady southerly breeze ranging from 7 to 10 knots. Because the wind came from the South, we had a spinnaker start.

The distance we chose was that of Course C, with the turn-around latitudes being between half a mile and a mile north of the Myers Point lighthouse.

The four boats competing were Mel Richards' C&C 30, LORELEI; Tim Bonniwell's Catalina 30, INVICTUS; Eberhard Alsen's Tanzer 25, FANTASY; and Clare Fewtrell's J-24, MEHITABEL.

The downwind part of the race was very close with all four boats being often less than a stone-throw apart. For the upwind part, the boats separated considerably, but the finish was a very close one with INVICTUS nosing out MEHITABEL by only about a foot.
