### Final Race Day of the Spring Series, Sunday, June 12

Isn't it great when the weather forecast is so gloriously wrong? NOAA weather called for multiple thunderstorms and showers, and all we got was a brief drizzle early in the morning. The rest of the day was partly sunny and partly overcast with temperatures in the high 60s and a WNW breeze, ranging from 7 to 9 with gusts to 18 knots

The competitors for this last race of the Spring Series were Mel Richards with his C&C 30, LORELEI; Tim Bonniwell with his Catalina 30, INVICTUS; David Feavearyear with his J-24, SNITCH; Brett Davis skippering Clare Fewtrell's J-24 MEHITABEL; Eberhard Alsen with his Tanzer 25, FANTASY; and the three Weta triamarans of Richard Stephens, Ben Arthur, and Keith Rice.

Fleet captain Tim Bonniwell set a course that took us first north to the Far Maplewood mark, then south to the Sycamore mark, from there northeast to the East Shore mark, then back across the lake to the Near Maplewood mark, and from there for a downwind finish to the Yacht Club.

In the keelboat class, David Feavearyear's SNITCH took line honors, but Tim Bonniwell's INVICTUS won the race on corrected time. In the Weta race, Richard Stephens continued his winning streak.

The Spring Series winner in the keelboat class is INVICTUS, skippered by Tim Bonniwell, and in the multihull class it is the equally invincible HONEY, skippered by Richard Stephens. Congratulations to Tim and Richard!
