Last Race Day of the Fall Series, Sunday, October 16

The sky was overcast with temperatures in the high 60s, and we had 8-15 knot winds veering wildly between SW and NW. Four keelboats and three Wetas showed up for this last Hurrah of the season. The keelboats were Mel Richard's C&C 30, LORELEI; Tim Bonniwell's Catalina 30, INVICTUS; Eberhard Alsen's Tanzer 25, FANTASY; and Dave Feavearyear's J-24, SNITCH. The Weta pilots were the usual suspects: Richard Stephens, Ben Arthur, and Keith Rice.

We had an absolute blast even though the wind kept shifting back and forth and one boat might be sailing north at 6 knots while another boat 100 yards away was creeping west at maybe 2 knots. The course we sailed was S to the Pile Cluster, N to East Shore, NW to Far Maplewood, S to Sycamore, and then N home to the finish line at the Yacht Club.

It was a close race with FANTASY leading most of the way. But SNITCH and INVICTUS caught up, and SNITCH captured line honors only to be narrowly beaten on corrected time by both INVICTUS and FANTASY (see attached photo). After crossing the finish line, FANTASY got hit by a monster puff and performed a spectacular broach. Her starboard spreader hit the water and her spinnaker flew from the mast like a flag and then turned into a sea anchor.

By winning this race, INVICTUS also won the Fall Series. Among the Wetas, HONEY did a horizon job on the other two triamarans, but with WETA 254 coming in second, Keith Rice cinched the series.
