First Latitude Race, Sunday, July 1

This is an update of the previous newsletter. When I wrote that last newsletter I did not yet have any information about the first latitude race because I was out of town. So here is the Fleet Captain's account of that first latitude race:

11 July 2012

Sorry this is so late. For the first Latitude race, we had 4 boats. *Trevelyan, Snitch, Invictus* & *Gipsy Moth.* They finished in that order.

We probably had 10-12 kts with gusts at the start. As the race proceeded and we neared Myers/Crowbar, the breeze built. Even with a double reefed main, *Invictus* broached on a beat in a gust that must have been 20+ kts. *Invictus* opted not to fly the chute and sailed downwind with double head sails and still reached speeds in the 8-8.5 kts range. *Gipsy Moth* also recorded speeds above 8 kts. *Trevelyan* did a horizon job on us all and saw speeds well into the double digits.

It was an exciting and beautiful day. A much better start to the Summer Series as compared to the Spring.
