50 Mile Night Race, Friday Juy 19

Only two boats showed up for this event, Tim Bonniwell's Catalina 30, INVICTUS and Bruce Cawards Bayfield 29, SERENITY. Bruce and crew decided to DNF after being becalmed for and hour and a half at Milliken Station. Tim and crew soldiered on and braved 30 knot winds near the 51A turn-around mark. Third Latitude Race, Sunday, July 21

The weather gods smiled on us and gave us perfect sailing conditions: Sunny skies with temperatures in the low 80s and a breeze of 9-13 knots from the NNW.

Five boats competed today: Tim Bonniwell's Catalina 30, INVICTUS: Susan Swensen's Cape Dory 28, QUETZAL III; Eberhard Alsen's Tanzer 25, FANTAS; Clare Fewtrell's J-24, MEHITABEL; and John Driscoll's O'Day 240, ALEA.

We once again sailed to the C set of latitudes, although some skippers were in favor of the longer D-course. But the weather on Cayuga Lake being as unpredictable as it is, we were afraid the slower boats might be stuck out there for a long time if the wind let up. As it turned out, the wind speed increased as the afternoon wore on, and we would have been o.k. with Course D.

Tim Bonniwell's Catalina 30 won again, followed by Clare Fewtrell's J-24, Eberhard Alsen's Tanzer 25, Susan Swensen's Cape Dory 28 and John Driscoll's O'Day 240.
