Fifth Latitude Race, Sunday, August 4

Some of us had been wishing for more wind than we had for the first four latitude races. Well, today we got our wish in spades. The NW wind averaged 19 knots with frequent gusts to 28. The winning J-24 clocked 10 knots going downwind under spinnaker. Because of the strong wind, we sailed to the D set of latitudes for the first time this year (For most boats that's just short of Taughannock).

We had five boats at the starting line: Tim Bonniwell's Catalina 30, INVICTUS: Susan Swensen's Cape Dory 28, QUETZAL III; Eberhard Alsen's Tanzer 25, FANTASY; David Feavearyear's J-24, SNITCH, and Clare Fewtrell's J-24, MEHITABEL.

The fleet was pretty well strung out on the upwind leg, but on the downwind leg there was a close race between INVICTUS and FANTASY who were both sailing with twin headsails instead of spinnakers. INVICTUS finally pulled ahead to finish two boat lengths in front of FANTASY. Meanwhile in front of the pack, SNITCH and MEHITABEL came in first and second.
