Sixth Latitude Race, Sunday, August 18

Four boats showed up for this next-to-last latitude race. Susan Swensen's Cape Dory 28, QUETZAL III: Eberhard Alsen's Tanzer 25, FANTASY; Clare Fewtrell's J-24, MEHITABEL; and David Feavearyear's J-24, SNITCH.

There was practically no wind when the race was scheduled to start at 1:30. Clare Fewtrell's motorless J-24, MEHIABEL, had to get a two from QUTEZAL to make it to the staring line. But no wind came up for a long time, and so we had three half-hour postponements.

After the first postponement, MEHITABE and SNITCH called it quits, with MEHITABEL being towed back to the South Pavilion by one of her crew, apparently a very strong swimmer.

QUETZAL and FANTASY stuck it out by rafting up and passing a bottle of rum back and forth. Around 2:45, a small breeze sprang up, and we decided to start at 3:00 and go to Latitude A.

The wind oscillated from SSE to SSW, but it not only held but gradually increased. While we were on our way north to our respective latitudes, we saw boat speeds of only 1.5 to 2.0 knots. But on the way back to the finish line, we were scooting along at 4.7 knots. FANTASY and QUETZAL finished a surprising first and second. Current latitude series standings are on the next page.
