Tune-Up Race, Sunday, April 27

Here's the race report from Charles Witherup, crew on INVICTUS:

For this year's Tune-Up Race, we had two boats: Richard Stephens' Corsair 28 TREVELYAN and Tim Bonniwell's Catalina 30 INVICTUS. It was a bit brisk out: overcast skies, winds 10-16kts from the NNW with gusts around 18, air temp was 47F - 6F more than the water.

The course was Far Maplewood, Pile Cluster, Far Maplewood - giving nice, lazy upwind and downwind legs with not a lot of tacking and gybing. Which was perfectly fine - it was, after all, a tune-up race!

We, on INVICTUS, held our usual position in the water with regard to TREVELYAN, which is to say that we watched them sail away from us! They threw up their spinnaker on rounding Far Maplewood. We were feeling less adventurous (and perhaps short a crew member) and opted for double headsails. While it was a simple matter getting the second headsail up and we were quickly under full steam it was apparent to us that going upwind feels a lot windier than going downwind! On our second rounding of Far Maplewood we got our spinnaker up (following TREVELYAN's lead and sail setting) and were able to hold one nice line back to IYC.

TREVELYAN won by 10 minutes corrected time (Details on the next page).
