Fifth Race Day of the Spring Series, Sunday, June 8

We had a pretty nice race day with partly sunny and partly overcast skies and a SSE breeze fluctuating between 5 and 12 knots.

Due to the absence of two of the usual suspects (the skippers and crews of LORELEI and SMILING BULLDOG), there were only five boats at the starting line: Tim Bonniwell's Catalina 30, INVICTUS; Richard Stephens' Corsair F28, TREVELYAN; Eberhard Alsen's Tanzer 25, FANTASY; Clare Fewtrell's J-24 MEHITABEL; and David Feavearyear's J-24, SNITCH.

Fleet Captain Keith Rice set just the right courses for the wind we had. In the first race we went all the way south to the Pile Cluster, then back up north to the Near Maplewood mark, and from there to an upwind finish to the Yacht Club. For the second race, we went south only to Sycamore, then back up north to the Far Maplewood mark, from there back to Sycamore, and then home for a spinnaker finish at the Yacht Club.

As always, Richard Stephens' TREVELYAN did a horizon job on the rest of the fleet. In the middle of the pack there was some spirited racing among the two J-24s of David Feavearyear and Clare Fewtrell and the Catalina 30 of Tim Bonniwell. They finished in that order in both races. Eberhard Alsen's Tanzer 25 finished way back both times as his new crew were getting familiar with the boat.
