Second Latitude Race, Sunday, July 6

We had absolutely gorgeous weather: Blue skies, temperatures in the low 70s, and a breeze from 9 to 12 knots shifting back and forth from SE to SW, with occasional lulls.

Five boats competed: Tim Bonniwell's Catalina 30, INVICTUS; Richard Stephens' Corsair 28, TREVELYAN; Eberhard Alsen's Tanzer 25, FANTASY; David Feavearyear's J-24, SNITCH; and Clare Fewtrell's J-24 MEHITABEL.

Despite the shifting and dying wind near the end of the race, the first three boats finished within a minute or so of each other.
