## Fifth Latitude Race, Sunday, August 3

After we all had reached our turn around latitudes, a light rain began to fall. Gradually that rain became more heavy and the wind became more shifty with gust of about 20 knots. By the time we approached the finish line, a major downpour set in with a wind shift to the SSW. It poured so hard that we found it difficult to see the A-buoy that marks the outer end of the finish line.
