## Red Jacket Race, Saturday, August 15

As usual for the Red Jacket Races, we did a Bermuda start with the slower boats starting earlier and the faster boats later.

We had plenty of sun but not enough wind. We started out with about 5-6 knots from the SE, but after Sheldrake Point the wind fizzled and it became apparent that we would not make it to the Red Jacket Yacht Club by the 5 p.m. deadline. Fleet Captain Keith Rice therefore got on the radio and told us to make sure to jot down our times as we passed Long Point because that would be our short course finish line if the wind did not pick up. And so it was because none of the six boats made it under sail to the Red Jacket Yacht Club before the 5 p.m. time limit expired.

The Red Jacket Yacht Club again put on a great event! When we arrived at the club's docks, we were greeted by the commodore who had two coolers of beverages ready for us. The dinner was fabulous with enormous portions of prime rib, tender baked fish, and succulent chicken cordon bleu.
