#### Fifth Race Day of the Fall Series, Sunday, October 11

We had sunny weather with temperatures in the low 70s and a southwesterly breeze ranging from 5 to 10 and occasionally dropping to Zero. But more vexing than the lulls were the wicked wind shifts. At the end of the second race, some of us spent many minutes tacking back and forth within a few boat lengths of the finish line, unable to cross.

We had six boats competing today. They were Bill Russell's Catalina 320, LITTLE WING; Tim Bonniwell's Catalina 30, INVICTUS (skippered by Charles Witherup); Richard Stephens' Corsair 28, TREVELYAN; Eberhard Alsen's Tanzer 25, FANTASY; David Feavearyear's J-24 SNITCH; and Clare Fewtrell's J-24 MEHITABEL (skippered by Dan Apfel).

The two racecourses that fleet captain Keith Rice set both involved the East Shore Mark. For the first race we went south to Sycamore, then across the lake to East Shore, from there back west to Far Maplewood, and then south to the Yacht Club. The shorter second race went south only to West Shore, but from there like the first race to Far Maplewood and then home.

Whie TREVELYAN took line honors in both races, SNITCH won the first race on corrected time and MEHITABEL won the second race. By notching up a first and a second place in today's two races, the SNITCH team nailed down the Fall Series even though there's one more race to go (See Standings on the next page). But MEHITABEL and TREVELYAN wound up tied for second place. So next Sunday's race will be a cliffhanger.

The skippers' meeting will be at 12:45 at the South Pavilion of the Ithaca Yacht Club. This time we plan to sail only one race and have the customary end-of-the-series cookout party afterwards.
