Fourth Race Day of the Spring Series, Sunday, June 5

Today only three intrepid skippers and crews braved the elements because the forecasts were for thunderstorms all the way from 12:00 noon to 4:00 p.m. Also, at the time of the skippers' meeting we experienced a torrential downpour.
