## Third Latitude Race, Sunday, July 24

For this race day we had partly sunny and partly overcast skies and temperatures in the middle 80s. The NNW wind ranged from 5 to 10 knots

Five boats showed up at the staring line plus one pretend racer. The five racing boats were Susan and Charles Witherup's Cape Dory 28, QUETZAL III; Eberhard Alsen's Tanzer 25, FANTASY; Dave Feavearyear's J-24, SNITCH; Clare Fewtrell's J-24 MEHITABEL (skippered by Dan Apfel); and Rob Whitcomb's Rhodes 19, FOLLOW ME. The pretend racer was Steve Supron's Ranger 29, RIPPLE, crewed by a teenage boy and a shaggy dog.

The course we sailed was to latitude C and back to the Yacht Club.

As usual, the two J-24 quickly pulled away from the rest of the fleet. They were the first boats to reach their latitudes and turn around with SNITCH leading MEHITABEL across the finish line. As the J-24s were going upwind, Steve Supron's Ranger 29 stayed ahead of one of them for quite a while and actually outpointed the Jay.

Far behind, FANTASY and QUETZAL fought a see-saw battle for third place. QUETZAL won by sailing closer to the middle of the lake where there was more wind.
