Spring Races 7 and 8!

The Fleet Captain and his Assistant were away so I got to have fun setting courses and being Race Committee. Given a nice 12ish knot wind from the SSE I set the first course to WINFCB ("Go Football Club Barcelona!"). The Fleet rejected my course so I removed some letters and made that **W**est Shore-**C**rowbar-**B**lue with C and B as starboard roundings. You'll note that since you generally leave marks to port it is, in fact, the same course :)

Six boats came out to compete in the races. We had Richard Stephens' Corsair 28 *Trevelyan*, Tim Bonniwell's J/70 *Ayla's Ride* helmed by Susan Witherup, Clare Fewtrell's J/24 *Mehitabel*, the Feavearyears' J/24 *Snitch* helmed by David, Bill Russell's Catalina 320 *Little Wing* helmed by Mike Newman, and Eberhard Alsen's Tanzer 25 *Fantasy*.

It was a clean and fast race (*Ayla's Ride* hit 13.7kts on the downwind leg – not bad for a keelboat!) with one funny hic in the middle. After rounding Crowbar Point *Trevelyan* didn't see the **C**rowbar mark where it should have been and apparently mistook a swimming buoy at the Girl Scout camp for it. As those buoys are far too close to shore to safely round, she sailed around the GPS coordinates where the mark should have been and continued on to **B**lue. When *Ayla's Ride* came around the Point she found **C**rowbar – just a bit further North and inshore of where it had been dropped. *Ayla's Ride* hailed *Trevelyan*, who had just rounded **B**lue, with the bad news. Rather than take a DSQ, *Trevelyan* sailed back around **C**rowbar and then **B**lue again! And then, to top all of it off, *Trevelyan* still took line honors despite having sailed more than 50% farther than anyone else! Good job Richard and crew!

The winds had been gradually but steadily building through the first race and by the time we were ready for our second race we were seeing 20kts with gusts at nearly 30. *Trevelyan* declined to race as she has some big events coming up in the near future and would like to keep her sails in top shape for those. The rest of us set off on the new course of **S**ycamore-**F**ar Maplewood-**W**est Shore-**N**ear Maplewood.

The race was a little less clean this time with all of the remaining boats involved in some kind of mess. First *Mehitabel* fouled *Little Wing* then *Little Wing* fouled *Ayla's Ride*. Later *Fantasy* fouled *Little Wing* and *Snitch* must have fouled her rig rounding the first leeward mark as she went, very quickly, from well in front of to well behind *Ayla's Ride*. And at some point in all of this *Mehitabel* tore her spinnaker (although, truth be told, that was probably in the first race it does sound better to put it in with the mishaps of the second one). All of the fouling (spinnaker aside) must have been worked out on the water as no one came to me with a formal protest.

And 15 minutes after the last boat finished the winds died...
