## Fall 5 and 6

We started off the docks for Fall 5 wondering if we should tighten up the rigging... we ended the day searching for winds.... welcome to sailing on Cayuga Lake. Joining us for this week's edition Cayuga Lake Cruisin' was: *Trevelyan, Snitch, Mehitabel, Fantasy*, and Little Wing.

For the first race of the day (Fall 5) the course was set for SAS (**S**ycamore, **A**, twice around). Some boats decided to head out into the lake, some stayed closer to shore... and it appeared that heading out paid off with just about everyone approaching the mark ahead of Snitch. The day was all about finding the puffs and calling the shifts. There was a moment making racers think we were participating in The Ocean Race (formerly The Volvo Ocean Race, formerly The Whitbread Race) as Little Wing had some trouble with their roller furling. We passed by to see two crew members working feverishly on the bow to repair the issue. The finishing order for this race was *Trevelyan, Snitch, Mehitabel, Fantasy*, and *Little Wing*.

The second race of the day (Fall 6) started off with great winds, and we are thankful for the pictures Charles posted to the Facebook page! The increased wind, the Fleet Captain was tempted to send us all to **P**ile Cluster.... SO GLAD THAT DIDN'T HAPPEN!! The second course was set as SFW (**S**ycamore, **F**ar Maplewood, **W**est Shore). As the race progressed, the wind speed became less and less. There were occasional gusts that caused some of us to heel more than others, however, those moments were few and far between. Once again, Trevelyan took line honors with *Snitch*, and *Mehitabel* about a leg behind, and *Fantasy* and *Little Wing* a little bit more behind.

Sadly, I can't offer any official results at this time and not all boats have recorded finish times. Perhaps in the future we should institute a policy that states if your time isn't reported by the Tuesday following the race your score will be recorded as Did Not Finish...

Well... that's an issue for another Fleet Captain to address.
